# Letter from the Director

As the new director of International Student and Scholar Services (ISSS), I am honored to lead my exceptional staff in our mission to provide culturally sensitive services of the highest quality to international students and scholars. We are happy to announce that the University of Illinois at Urbana-Champaign (UIUC) ranks 2nd amongst US public institutions hosting international students (5th overall) and 14th for scholars, rankings that demonstrate the university's ongoing commitment to international education.

The UIUC welcomed a record 3151 new international students to campus this fall. The top three countries represented were China (1571), India (365) and South Korea (312) accounting for 71% of our new student population. New undergraduate degree students continued to outnumber new graduate degree students this year; with 1453 (46.1%) and 1237 (39.3%), respectively. Incoming freshman were still the largest single group, numbering 1001. We also welcomed 461 non-degree and professional students to campus this year.

The number of enrolled international students is also at an all-time high of 10208, an increase of 3.9% from Fall 2014. Graduate degree students account for 46.2% (4714) of the international enrollment, and comprise 46% of the overall graduate student population at the UIUC. Undergraduate degree students make up 48.8% (4986) of the international student enrollment, and 15.2% of the overall UIUC undergraduate student population. In total, international students comprise 23.2% of the student body at the UIUC.

Our students represent 112 countries, with 85.8% coming from Asia. The top five countries of origin are: China (5241), India (1241), South Korea (1182), Taiwan (284), and Iran (137).


From July 2014 through June 2015, the UIUC welcomed 2015 international faculty and staff to its campus. 22.4% were working and researching in Engineering, followed by 11.5% in the Physical Sciences and another 9.2% in Biological and Biomedical Sciences. The most represented country was China, with 798 faculty and staff, followed by India (195), South Korea (157), Brazil (127) and Canada (54).

ISSS is proud to serve so many talented international students, faculty and staff at the University of Illinois at Urbana-Champaign by not only being the primary point of contact for all matters related to immigration status at the university, but also by being advocates for our international population and providing social and educational programming throughout the year. We look forward to continue to work with this special group of people in the upcoming year.






#### **TOTAL STUDENT ENROLLMENT SUMMARY**




#### **NEW STUDENT SUMMARY**



#### **New Student Distribution by Degree Level**









### Undergraduate Student Enrollment 2011 - 2015









### Graduate Student Enrollment 2011 - 2015




### Top 5 Countries



# **Graduate Student Top 10 Departments**




#### **Distribution by College**
